

Dress Code

The ASU dress code is an important factor in our school culture. The dress code is enforced throughout the school year. Students are expected to wear school uniforms from Monday to Thursday. Students are not permitted to dye their hair with unnatural or distracting colors. Hats should not be worn in the school building.

The ASU uniform is as follows:

- ASU zippered jacket
- ASU Zippered hoodie
- ASU polo shirt with long or short sleeves
- ASU issued (bearing the ASU logo) **trousers** (for boys or girls) and skirts (for girls). Girls may wear black tights under their skirt.
- Shoes:
 - **Must be “non-scuff” soles (no marks on floor)**
 - Athletic shoes, sneakers, etc. are permitted all day but **must be black or predominantly black** (some grey/white elements are allowed);
 - Dress shoes or boots **must be black or predominantly black** (some small grey or white elements are allowed)
 - No “decorations”, bright colors, shiny metal elements etc.
- Special jackets and hoodies might be allowed on a case-by-case basis, but the uniform must be worn under all jackets.

Violations of the dress code will have consequences including

- Parents will be called and required to bring a change of clothing
- Students will not attend classes class for the day, and work in a “detention area”
- Students may be sent home or assigned in-school suspension for more than one day for repeated violations.

It is the parent’s responsibility to ensure that children are wearing compliant clothing.

Fridays are ‘free dress’ days when students may wear non-uniform clothes. Students may be sent home if their attire is deemed inappropriate by faculty or administration. For more information about the school uniform and the ASU dress code, please contact the Student Services office.

Prohibited:

- Ripped clothing
- Clothing that shows any skin between the neckline and the knee areas (e.g. crop tops)
- Tank tops, “muscle shirts”, “spaghetti straps” tops, mini-skirts or similar short skirts, shorts, etc.
- Clothing that contains obscenities, disturbing messages, etc.
